## Requirements:

1. Have a relationship with Jesus that is lived out in your lifestyle.
2. Regularly attend all training sessions (Dates TBA)
  - At least 10 hours of mandatory training
  - Will not be able to miss training and go on trip
3. Completion of LCC's Connect Class ("Do the Five")
4. Scripture memory—we will all learn ten verses, and Alumni will learn other verses in addition to these.
5. Practice spiritual disciplines: daily devotional life, prayer, some journaling and practice in fasting.
6. Regular attendance at LCC
7. Read a mission's book—pick your own or get suggestions from team leader.
8. Short oral interview with Mission Board (made up of Elders and Mission Team members). Mission Board determines applicant's final approval.
9. Willingness to follow Philippians 2:14: "Do everything without complaining or arguing."
10. Work diligently to pay all trip costs by or before deadlines.
11. Submit application and deposit ASAP.
12. Establish three trip Prayer Partners (other than fellow Team Mates and Spouses).

## Commitments:

1. I will make this trip a priority and make time for all training, requirements and personal devotional time.
2. I will cheerfully follow the team leadership as well as the missionaries and national pastors. I will follow direction even if it is different than my own personal opinion.
3. I will use Scriptural principles of conflict resolution with other team members.
4. Understanding that there is a diversity of conviction among Believers, we ask that during the duration of the trip that there will be no purchase or use of alcohol or tobacco products.

## **Philippians 2:1-11**

<sup>1</sup>If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from His love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, <sup>2</sup>then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose. <sup>3</sup>Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. <sup>4</sup>Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. <sup>5</sup>Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: <sup>6</sup>Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped <sup>6</sup>but made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. <sup>8</sup>And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to death—even death on a cross! <sup>9</sup>Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup>that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup>and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to
